- Record of blocking points: doors, signage, alarm sounders
- Written report and list of corrections to make

Teaching methods and resources

Assessment

Timing of the evacuation and the headcount, note of the blocking points, written report and list of corrections.

Trainer

A trainer from professional emergency services: nurse, firefighter or military. Their identity, qualifications and professional liability certificate are sent to you before the session.
